Your Own Sangmo!

Teachers: Placing the paper bowl on the center of the plate, trace a circle just larger than the diameter of the plate. Using an X-Acto knife, cut out the circle. Continue until you have enough bowls and plate-hat rims for all students.

Students: Apply a layer of glue to edge of your bowl and affix it to a plate-rim. Once dry, decorate the hat with crepe paper streamers, markers, paint. Don't forget the the pom poms! Finally take a streamer of your choice and cut it as long as you want. Using one of the fasteners, affix the streamer to the top of the hat.

Teachers: Cut two lengths of string and affix them to the inside of the hat with the paper fasteners. When tied together under the chin, this will ensure the hat doesn't fall off the students head when they move.
